- (b) Name the character who commits suicide at the beginning of Agatha Christie's *The Murder of Roger Ackroyd*.
- (c) Name any one place that Tintin visits while stopping over in Delhi.
- (d) Which character in Sukumar Ray's *Abol Tabol* is referred to as the ideal bridegroom?
- (e) Mention the character who refuses to laugh and smile in Sukumar Ray's *Abol Tabol*.

Answer the following questions (within 600 words each) :

2. (a) Consider Lewis Carroll's *Through the Looking Glass* as a story of growing up. 15

(b) Assess Lewis Carroll's combination of realism and fantasy in *Through the Looking Glass*. 15
3. (a) Assess the role of Hercule Poirot as a detective in Agatha Christie's *The Murder of Roger Ackroyd*. 15
Or,
(b) Comment on the ending of Agatha Christie's novel *The Murder of Roger Ackroyd*. 15
4. (a) Friendship and bonding form the basis of the plot of *Tintin in Tibet*. Discuss. 15

(b) Comment on the role played by the Yeti in *Tintin in Tibet*. 15
5. (a) *Abol Tabol* is much more than children's literature. It has a serious social relevance. Discuss with reference to any two poems. 15

(b) Justify the title of *Abol Tabol* with reference to its contents. 15
